# ABOUT THE CONDUCTOR



**Known for his entertaining programs and engaging personality, Michael Krajewski is a much sought-after pops conductor in the U.S.A., Canada and abroad.** His 20-year relationship with the Houston Symphony included 17 years as Principal Pops Conductor. He also served as Principal

Pops Conductor of the Long Beach Symphony for 11 years, Principal Pops Conductor of Atlanta Symphony for eight years, Music Director of the Philly Pops for six years, and Principal Pops Conductor of the Jacksonville Symphony for 25 years.

Michael's busy schedule as a guest conductor includes concerts with major and regional orchestras across the United States. In Canada, he has appeared with the orchestras of Toronto, Ottawa, Vancouver, Calgary, Edmonton, Winnipeg, Regina, and Kitchener-Waterloo. Overseas, he has performed in Ireland, Spain, the Czech Republic, Iceland, Malaysia, and China. Michael has conducted concerts featuring notable musicians and entertainers from many diverse styles of music. He has worked with classical luminaries such as vocalist Marilyn Horne, flutist James Galway, pianist Alicia de Larrocha, and guitarists Pepe and Angel Romero.

In the field of popular music, he has performed with Roberta Flack, Judy Collins, Art Garfunkel, Kenny Loggins, Ben Folds, Rufus Wainright, Jason Alexander, Patti Austin, Sandi Patty, Megan Hilty, Matthew Morrison, Doc Severinsen, the Preservation Hall Jazz Band, The Chieftains, Chicago, Pink Martini, and Big Bad Voodoo Daddy.

Born in Detroit, Michael studied music education at Wayne State University and conducting at the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music. He was an Antal Dorati Fellowship Conductor with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra (DSO) and subsequently served as the DSO's assistant conductor for four years. Michael now lives in Florida with his wife Darcy. In his spare time he enjoys travel, photography, and solving crossword puzzles.

Not only is Mick Adams a ringer for Mick Jagger, he brings Mick Jagger's intense energy to each performance. As a former lead vocalist for Bo Donaldson and the Heywoods (where he performed for Dick Clark), Adams has toured the country with the likes of Tommy James, The Turtles, The Monkees, The Association, The Lovin' Spoonful, The Buckingham, Herman's Hermits, Ron Dante, the Rascals, and more. Other notables that Adams has performed with include Spencer Davis, Rick Springfield, Johnny Rivers, Neil Sedaka, America, and Rock and Roll Hall-of-Famer Sam Moore.

Adams has recorded with Mark Kendall of Great White as well as Ronnie James Dio's guitarist, Tracy G, and has done voice over work for MADD TV. He has also performed on various telethons, including Betty White's pet telethon, Jerry Lewis' MS telethon, and many others. Adams' band, Mick Adams and The Stones, has performed for everyone from Brad Pitt, Will Ferrell, Leslie Bibb, David Spade, Amy Adams, Flava Flav, Jack McBrayer, Judd Apatow, as well as Mark Cuban. They have been featured on national television multiple times, toured internationally, and have appeared on and recorded for AXS televisions, The World's Greatest Tribute Bands. They have also been named one of the top ten tributes in the world by *Backstage 360* magazine. Adams is endorsed by Mark Cuban, Ryan Seacrest and former President of Atlantic Records, Jerry Greenberg, who signed The Rolling Stones.

**Mick Adams' incredible voice, range, and power speak for themselves.** Born in Columbus, Ohio, Adams began singing at three years old. By the age of eight, he was the only child singing with the local adult church choir. While in high school, he studied voice under

Elizabeth Graham and was a featured soloist in the high school choir. Adams continued his vocal education
